Canyon Creek Nursery is a full retail and wholesale nursery open to the public and landscape trade. We specialize in perennials, shrubs, and trees, both potted and ball and burlap. Since this is Billings, the majority of what we sell is for Zone 4 but we know that many folks have micro-climates in their yard and can make a few Zone 5 plants work. This season we are dipping our toe into hardy water plants for the Billings area. We carry a variety of bulk wood bark mulch, decorative rock ground cover, gravel, compost, soil and boulders as well as bagged compost and bark mulch. We also carry a few basic chemicals and deer repellents for homeowners. We do not have a landscape division and we do not do snow removal. When customers are looking for someone to plant for them we offer a list of landscapers we have met through the nursery and let customers make a direct connection.

Customer service is what sets a business apart and we strive to help our customers choose the right plant for the right spot in their yard. That means we ask dozens of questions about location, sun light, water, and wildlife pressure (to name a few). Many times folks go home to do homework and they can visualize the plants they have seen at the nursery.

We continue to expand our ability to help our landscape trade customers by providing bids and obtaining material for their customer projects. We offer a trade discount off our retail pricing. We encourage landscapers to stop in and see what we have or send their customer in to shop as they are putting bids together.

To tie Stacey's vision together, Land Design, Inc. now has their office here at the nursery and it's a great collaboration of design and availability of plants. We look forward to the opportunity to collaborate with Thirsty Street Brewing to bring a brew pub to our customer experience in the coming year, so stay tuned.
