Bitterroot Turf Farm

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Bitterroot Turf Farm is owned and operated by Dave Trihey. The business is located in Corvallis, Montana, just off the Eastside Highway, five miles north of town. Bitterroot Turf Farm specializes in sod grown from seed, and their blends are guaranteed to grow well in the Montana climate.

The farm grows several blends of turf including: Kentucky Blue Blend, Fescue Blend, and Northwest Native Mix. The Kentucky Blue Blend is their most popular blend, as it will grow well in sun and partial shade, as well as tolerate the foot traffic of family outdoor activities. The Fescue Blend also can be used in lawn areas, and is more drought tolerant than the Kentucky Blue Blend. The Northwest Native Mix is mainly used for restoration projects around the state, and is comprised of 66% turf type Fescues and 34% Canadian Bluegrass.

Bitterroot Turf Farm produces sod available in ten square foot size hand rolls, as well as large machine rolls, which can be up to 400 square feet in size. The company offers help with the installation of the large rolls as well.

Local delivery area includes Missoula, Frenchtown, Hamilton, Florence and Stevensville. Their friendly and timely delivery drivers will also drive to all areas of western Montana and Idaho to bring you their top quality, mature, and weed free sod. The drivers also will be equipped with a fork-lift to place the pallets where necessary to make for an efficient installation at your job site.
